HEALTH AND MEDICATION INFORMATION

- 1. Students should remain at home for a temperature of 99° or higher and must be fever free for 24 hours without medication in order to return to school.
- 2. Students should remain at home if they have vomited or experienced diarrhea within the last 12 hours.
- 3. Students should remain at home is they have an undiagnosed rash. If a student has poison ivy/oak, the affected area(s) must be covered at all times.
- 4. If a student is suspected to have pink eye, the parent will be notified, and the student must be seen by a physician and receive a readmit slip to return to school.
- 5. Please familiarize yourself with the LICE policy in the handbook.
- 6. All OTC (over the counter) medications must have a written note from the parent (see below). OTC and prescription medications MUST be in their original container (No Ziploc bags) and MUST be brought to the school by the parent/guardian. Students are not allowed to transport medications.
- 7. Parents are encouraged to keep the nurse/teacher informed of any and all changes to the student's medical status and/or medications.
