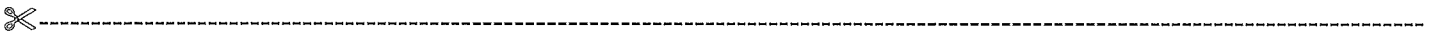
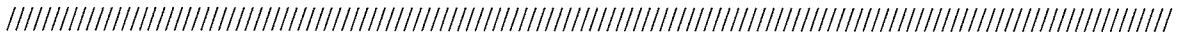


HEALTH AND MEDICATION INFORMATION

1. Students should remain at home for a temperature of 99° or higher and must be fever free for 24 hours without medication in order to return to school.
2. Students should remain at home if they have vomited or experienced diarrhea within the last 12 hours.
3. Students should remain at home is they have an undiagnosed rash. If a student has poison ivy/oak, the affected area(s) must be covered at all times.
4. If a student is suspected to have pink eye, the parent will be notified, and the student must be seen by a physician and receive a readmit slip to return to school.
5. Please familiarize yourself with the LICE policy in the handbook.
6. All OTC (over the counter) medications must have a written note from the parent (see below). OTC and prescription medications **MUST** be in their original container (No Ziploc bags) and **MUST** be brought to the school by the parent/guardian. Students are not allowed to transport medications.
7. Parents are encouraged to keep the nurse/teacher informed of any and all changes to the student's medical status and/or medications.
